Additions to the NCC Handbook

The Secretary should confirm to the NCC Secretary that anyone involved with Working With Children has been registered as such for the <Sub Committee> in accordance with the NCC's Safeguarding Children Policy and Code Of Conduct.

All activities should be conducted on the basis that the NCC Code of Conduct or an equivalent Code of Conduct is deemed to apply to all attendees.

To ensure our duty of care to our community, all events requiring an application / registration process, should remind all applicants that they must agree with, or will be deemed to agree with, the NCC Code of Conduct or alternatively a targeted event Code of Conduct, as developed by the Committee, that is appropriate and comprehensive for the event.

Communication to all NCC Committees

To ensure our duty of care to our community, Committees are reminded that all events requiring an application / registration process, should remind all their applicants that they must agree with, or will be deemed to agree with, the NCC Code of Conduct or alternatively a targeted event Code of Conduct, as developed by the Committee, that is appropriate and comprehensive for the event.
